

Vim

Basic commands

`:w [file]` Write to *file*
`:x` Exit, saving changes
`:q` Exit as long as there have been no changes
`:q!` Exit and ignore any changes
`:wq` Save file and exit

Inserting Text

`i` Insert before cursor
`I` Insert before line
`r` Replace one character
`R` Enter insert mode, but replace

Motion

`h` Move left
`j` Move down
`k` Move up
`l` Move right
`w` Move to next word
`W` Move to next blank delimited word
`e` Move to the end of the word

Cut/Copy and paste

1. Position the cursor where you want to begin cutting or copying
2. Press `v` (or `V` if you want to cut whole lines)

3. Move the cursor to the end of what you want to cut or copy
4. Press `d` or Press `y`
5. Move to where you would like to paste
6. Press `p` to paste after the cursor, or `P` to paste before

Undo and Repeat

1. Enter the command mode
2. Press `u` for "undo"

Redo

3. Best way is to enter "redo" in last line mode
4. Another way is to Press `Ctrl+r`
